RDF contributed towards her education as she turned 19 last year and took admission in a nursing college in Raipur (Chattisgarh) Dhamtari Christian Nursing College. Munni R has entered her second year of nursing. Munni sings beautifully in hindi and bhojpuri and few english songs too. As an organisation we are blessed to support youth who are willing to achieve and reach their goals. Her hard work and determination brings hope, encouragement and motivation to other young lives.

Course details-Three year Nursing & Midwifery course from **School & College of Nursing Dhamtari Bihar India**. Total fee is INR 383,940. Amount raised and paid INR 123,650. Support is required for balance amount of INR 260,290 which includes her meals, stay and course fee.

Her father is a plumber by profession and mother is a housewife. Her family suffered a lot during lockdown and struggled to meet their basic needs. Due to financial crisis she was not able to go for further studies in regular college, but by the grace of God she is now doing Diploma in Pharmacy from Shashi Kote College of Pharmacy (BVR Group of Institute) Bengaluru, Karnataka. Her course duration is 2 years. She has a dream to open her own medical store and serve the underserved community around her.

Course Fee - Two Year Diploma in Pharmacy- INR 169,000

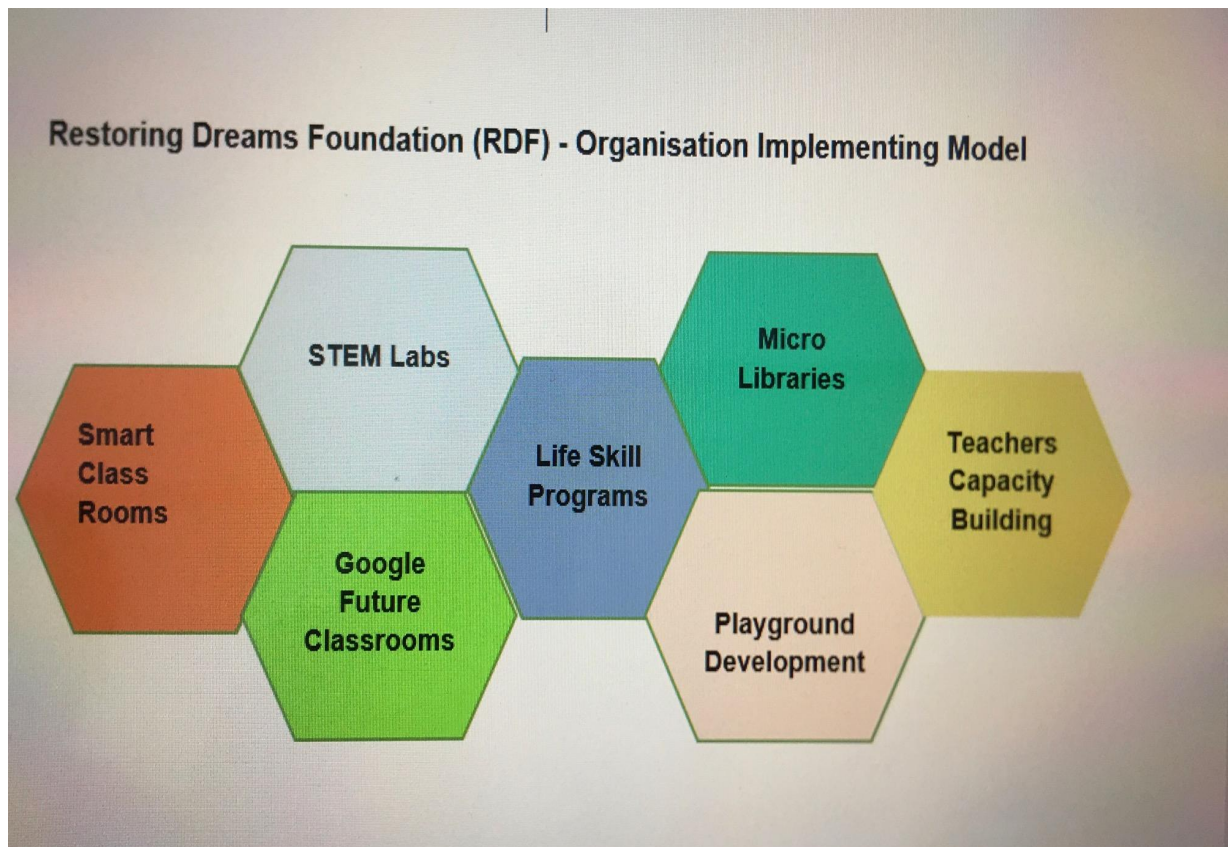

Our goal is that every adolescent girl in India, completes secondary school and is safe, strong and empowered. We have reached to **500 young girls** this year in CBD Belapur schools .

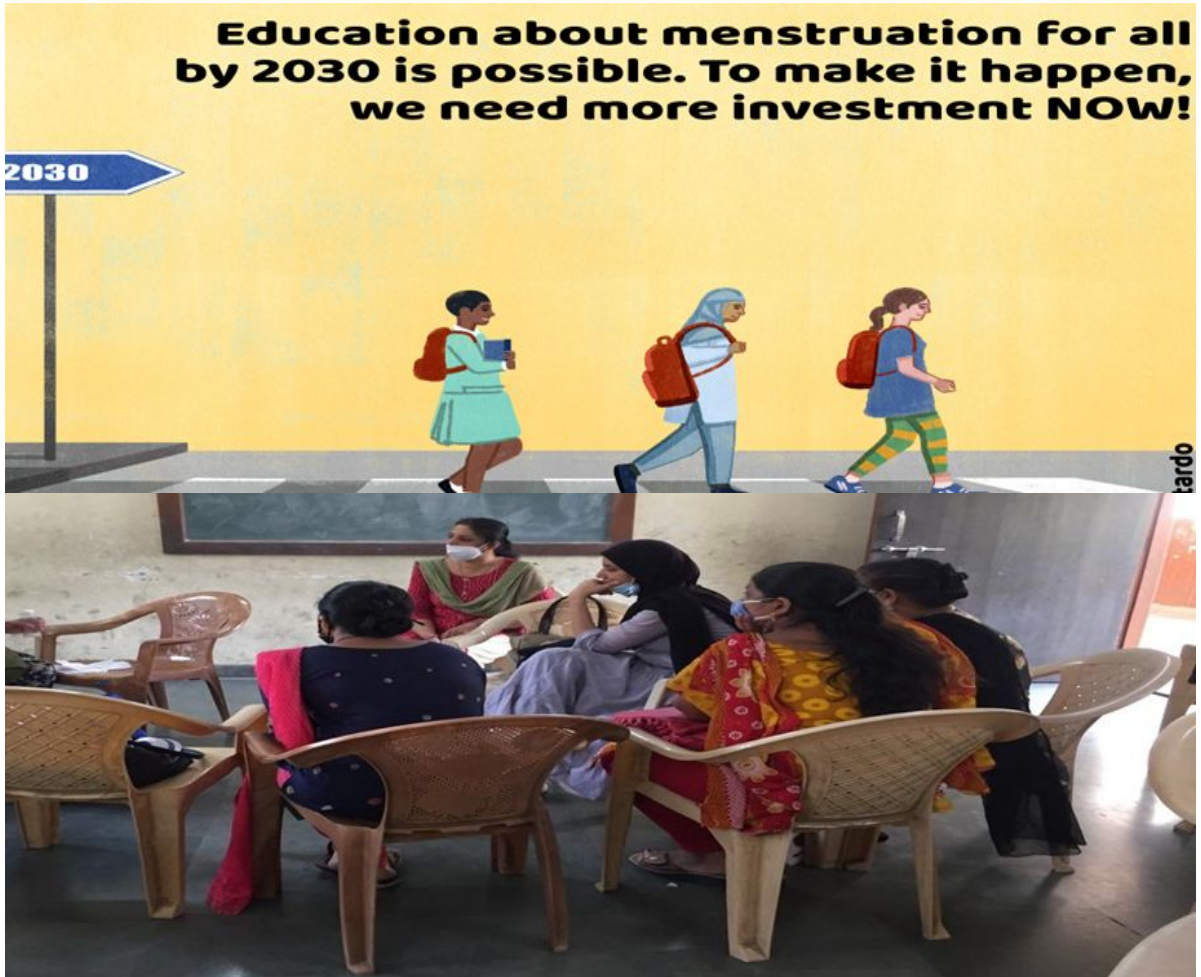


Open Heart Surgery- Modern approaches mean that open heart surgery has been revolutionized and is now an entirely different prospect compared to what it used to be.
